


### What Area Are We Focusing On?

- It also includes NM 90 from Broadway to US 180.

## Phase 1: US 180 | NM 90 | 14<sup>th</sup> Street


The first set of improvements moving into design development is focused on the intersection of US 180, NM 90, and 14th Street.

### In 2023, a Road Safety Audit identified key concerns in this area, including:

- A high crash rate at the intersection of US 180 and NM 90
- Limited pedestrian and bicycle facilities
- Opportunities to improve traffic flow and safety access

#### The Phase 1 would include opportunities to:


- Improve safety and efficiency at one of the busiest intersections in Silver City
- Provide improved pedestrian and bicycle access
- Update aging roadway features to better serve all users
