

I-25 Nogal Canyon Bridge Replacement Project

OVERVIEW

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT), in coordination with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), is replacing the Interstate 25 (I-25) truss bridges over Nogal Canyon at Milepost 107 in Socorro County with two new structures. The new structures and surrounding roadway will be updated to meet current safety and performance standards. The new cast-in-place segmental concrete girder bridges and roadway improvements will enhance safety, stability, and long-term reliability along this section of I-25.

PURPOSE



IMPROVE Safety for drivers and freight traffic.




ENSURE long-term reliability of New Mexico's interstate network.

- ▢ **Drainage improvements** to the existing slopes and canyon
- ▢ **Slope stability improvements** including erosion improvements
- ▢ **New signing and striping** to enhance visibility and safety
