**In 2023, a Road Safety Audit identified key concerns in this area, including:**

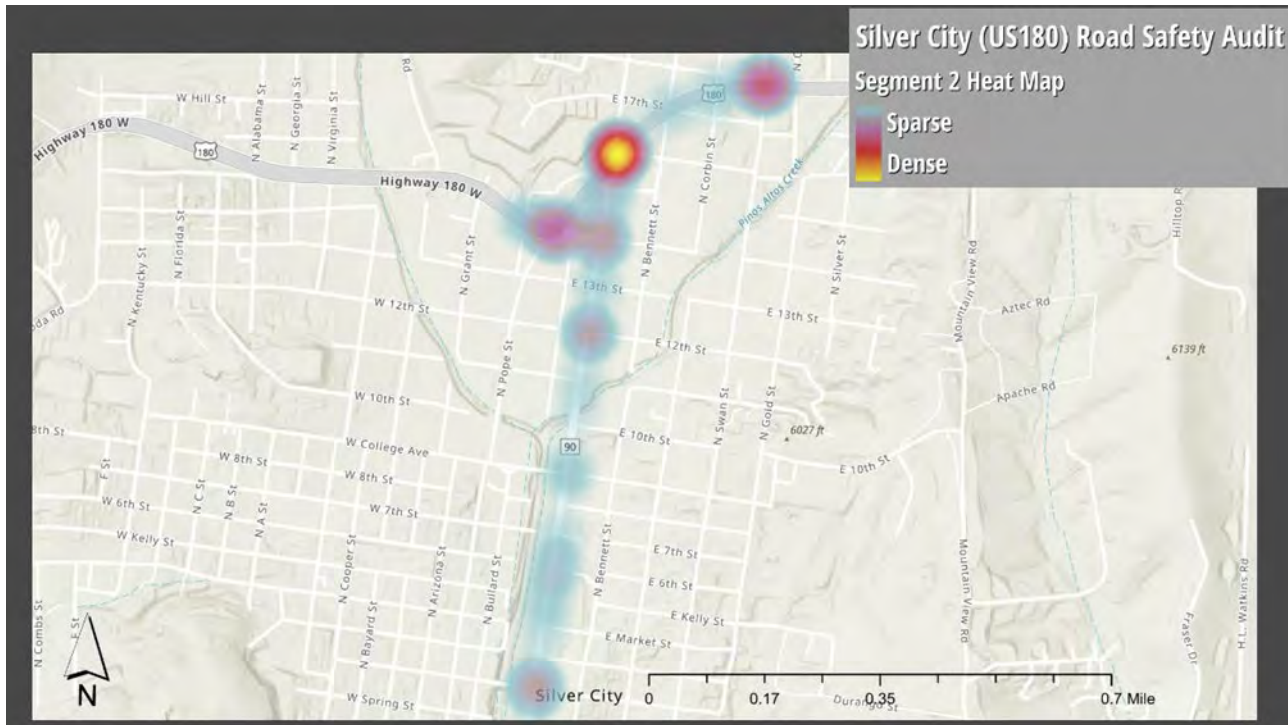
- A high crash rate at the intersection of US 180 and NM 90
- Limited pedestrian and bicycle facilities
- Opportunities to improve traffic flow and safety access

**The Project would include opportunities to:**

- Improve safety and efficiency at one of the busiest intersections in Silver City
- Provide improved pedestrian and bicycle access
- Update aging roadway features to better serve all users

# Traffic Volumes

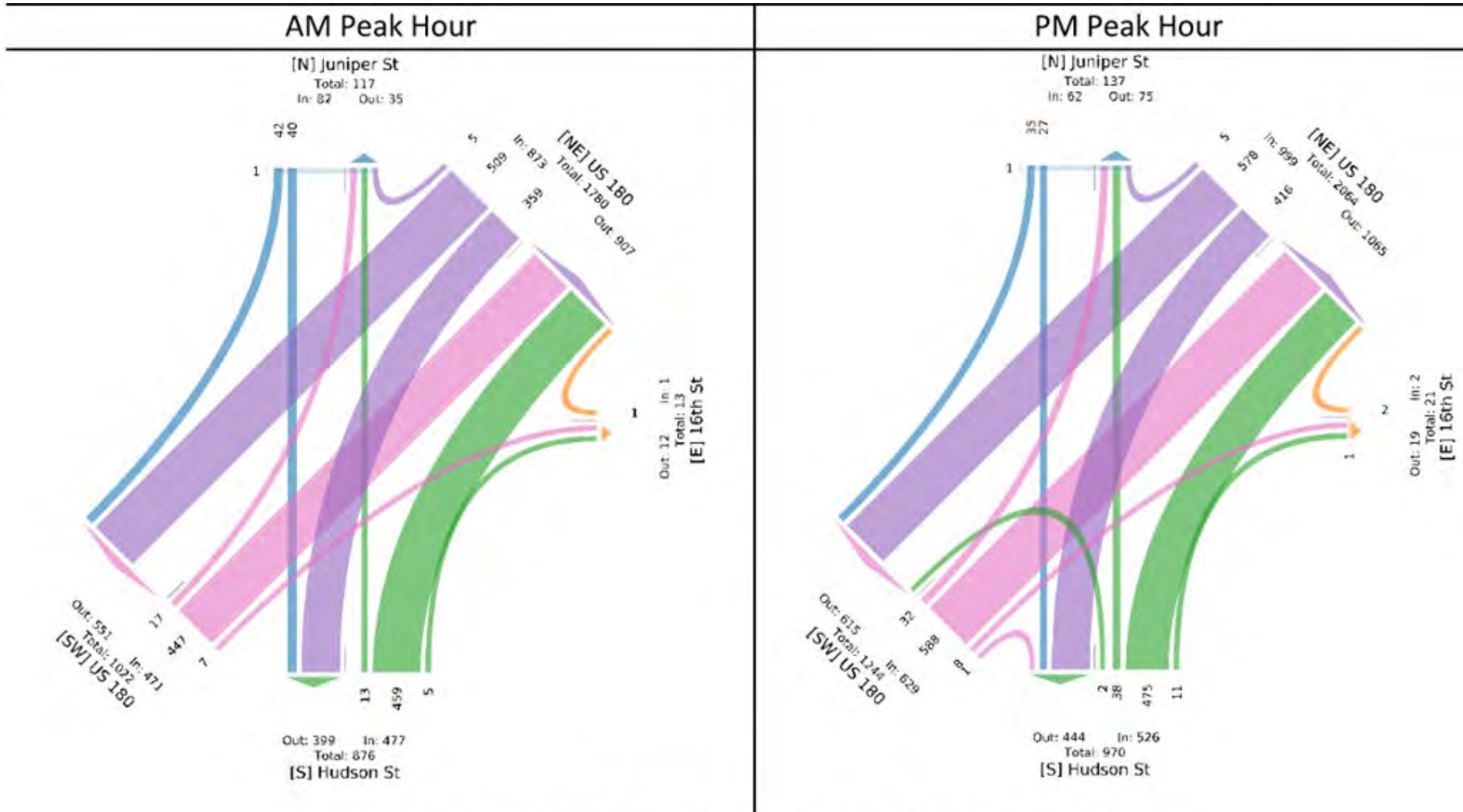


Figure 10: US 180 & NM 90 (Hudson St.)/Juniper St./16th St. Existing Volumes
